

**The defendant must attend school during school hours**  
(Education Requirement)

**The defendant's parents must attend counselling and ensure that their child is attending school** (Parenting Order)

**The defendant is not allowed to visit a certain area**  
(Exclusion Requirement)

**The defendant is sent to the other side of the world to work in a penal colony** (Transportation)

**The defendant is beaten with a whip or stick as a physical punishment** (Flogging)

**The defendant must attend a strict school where they will be taught a trade** (Reform School)

**The defendants must pay money to the court** (Fine –Adult)

**The defendant must work for the community for free such as litter picking (Reparation Order)**

**The defendant's parents must pay money to the court (Fine—Youth)**

**No punishment is given but the defendant will have to stay out of trouble for 3 years (Conditional Discharge)**

**The defendant is sent to a secure site with other young offenders that they cannot leave (Young Offenders Institute)**

**The defendant cannot see certain people (Prohibited Activity Requirement)**

**The defendant must attend a centre run by the police for physical training and to learn social skills (Attendance Centre)**

**The defendants must not leave their house after a certain time (Curfew)**

**The defendant is killed with a rope around the neck (Hanging)**

**The defendant must regularly meet with a social work (Supervision Requirement)**

**The defendant is given a sentence which is tailored to them it will contain more than one thing and can last up to 3 years (Youth Rehabilitation Order)**

**The defendant is made to carry out pointless physical work (Hard Labour)**

**The defendant is sent to a secure site with adults that they cannot leave (Jail)**
